

MOROCCO (FRENCH)

Unlike the rest of North Africa, Morocco had remained nominally independent under the Alaouite dynasty. Growing European interests led to secret treaties between France, Britain and Spain, to protect their interests in opposition to those of Germany. By the 1912 Treaty of Fez, France established a protectorate over Morocco, with the exception of the northern 10% of the country which became a Spanish Protectorate.

France promoted European settlement, and development of agricultural and mineral resources. French civil servants organised the taxation, with a major simplification in 1925 when the General Revenue fiscal stamps were introduced to replace a complicated and unproductive tax structure. Key types were used for most issues. The pentagram star design is the Seal of Solomon, symbol of the Alaouite dynasty.

In WWII, the French in Morocco were initially tacit supporters of the Vichy regime, but the Allied landings in 1942 brought a change of allegiance to the Allied side. In the immediate postwar period the national independence movement gained ground. The French tried to take a firm hand and exiled the Moroccan ruler Mohammed V to Madagascar. Rising violence in Morocco and demand for real home rule brought a return of Mohammed V from exile, first as Sultan in 1955, then as King in 1957. Between 1955 and 1956 agreements were reached recognising the end of the Protectorate status and the full independence of Morocco as a kingdom, though still with economic links to France. Currency in the former French part remained as the Moroccan Franc, until replaced by the Dirham in 1960. The former Spanish area was gradually incorporated into the unified regime and this area adopted the Moroccan Franc in 1958.

For convenience of identification, we have listed all stamps denominated in French Francs in this section (even though those of 1957-59 were made as the Kingdom of Morocco). For issues from 1960 in Dirham currency, see under Morocco (Independent).





MOROCCO (FRENCH) - CONNAISSEMENTS (BILLS OF LADING)

Four part stamps, A : the first stamp with face value was affixed to the shipper's original bill of lading document, and B : the matching "Control" stamps were affixed as proof of tax payment to one, two or three official counterparts. Control stamps had no face value; single examples can only be linked to the matching face value by their colour and watermark.

Limited extra printings of controls were also produced with stamp values se tenant in one sheet for small users or for triplicate copies. The following vertical pairs of stamp values are reported : 5c+25c (confirmed by us), 10c+15c (?); and horizontal pairs : 15c+20c, 45c+50c, 2F+2F50. The reported vertical combinations do not match an obvious sheet layout, while the horizontal combinations do match a sequential increase to the next value.



These stamps were later replaced by imprinted impressions of the tax stamps made directly on the tickets.



MOROCCO (FRENCH) - TABAC

Tobacco.



A wide range of issues exist in styles like the above, from the period 1920s to 1950s. Where values are expressed, these are the retail price of the packet of cigarettes or tobacco with the tax included in the end price; many are totally without value shown. These are all taxpaid and outside the scope of adhesive revenues. There is an excellent listing of these issues in Duston "French Colonies - North Africa & Middle East". Typical values say 5.00 to 10.00.
